Orders are due by October 15. Orders received after Oct 15 are not guaranteed to be filled. You do **not** have to collect money as you take preorders but if you do, and the payment is a check, please turn checks in asap!

Placing your order: After you have totaled your order sheet for each item listed, please round your order up to the nearest case of 12 for each item. In other words, if you have orders for 9 bags of pecans pieces, go ahead and order a full case (12). This ensures you have extras for those requests you get after the deadline of Oct 15. Pecan recipes:

Saltine Cracker Candy with Toasted Pecans (Crack Crackers)

35 saltines

- 1 cup butter, cubed (save the wrappers!)
- 1 cup packed brown sugar
- 2 cups semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 cup chopped pecans, toasted

Preheat oven to 350°. Line a 15x10x1 baking sheet with foil; use the butter wrappers to grease the foil or spray with cooking spray. Arrange saltines in a single layer. In a large heavy saucepan, melt butter over medium heat. Stir in brown sugar. Bring to a boil; cook and stir 3-4 minutes or until sugar is dissolved. Spread evenly over crackers with an offset spatula.

Bake 8-10 minutes or until bubbly. Immediately

Bake 8-10 minutes or until bubbly. Immediately sprinkle with chocolate chips. Allow chips to soften for a few minutes, then spread with an offset spatula covering all crackers. Sprinkle with pecans. Cool slightly. Refrigerate, uncovered, 1 hour or until set. Break into pieces. Store in an airtight container. Make about 2 pounds.

Pecan Praline Pie Bark

2 sleeves (about 20 or so) Honey Graham crackers

- 1 cup butter
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 1 ½ cups chopped pecans

Preheat oven to 350°. Line a rimmed baking sheet with foil: use the butter wrappers to grease the foil or spray with cooking spray. Place the graham crackers all over the pan edge to edge, breaking apart to fill in any gaps. In a medium saucepan, mix the butter and brown sugar. Bring to a boil over medium heat and boil for 2 minutes, stirring constantly. Stir in vanilla and chopped pecans. Pour the hot mixture over the graham crackers. Working quickly, use an offset spatula to spread to coat all graham crackers.

Bake for 10 minutes or until the mixture is brown and bubbly. Allow the bark to cool completely. Break into pieces and store in an airtight container.
